## WHAT TO WATCH FOR

## CONTACT YOUR DOCTOR IMMEDIATELY IF YOU EXPERIENCE ANY OF THESE SYMPTOMS:

- ► Fever of 100.4 °F or higher
- ► Shaking; chills
- ► Chest pain or shortness of breath
- ► Excessive bleeding or bruising; clotting issues
- **▶** Confusion
- ► Severe headache with a stiff neck
- ► Bloody or cloudy urine

- Diarrhea that lasts more than two days without improvement;
  bloody or black stool
- Signs of dehydration: excessive thirst, dry mouth, dry skin, little or no urination, dark-colored urine, severe weakness, dizziness or lightheadedness
- ► Severe abdominal or rectal pain
- ► Heart palpitations

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
